Building Peace at Home

Too many of us feel numbed and helpless about the violence destroying the lives of young people in their schools. What can be done?

The Hamilton Township, New Jersey school district has a Peacemaking Project. Every day students recite "A Pledge for Peace." It reads, in part, "I pledge to be a peaceful person . . . In my school, with my family, my community. I pledge not to fight with others. I pledge to make my world a more peaceful place for children to be safe, happy and peaceful. I pledge to set a peaceful example."

Youngsters are also taught conflict resolution: Cool off. State feeling through "I" messages. No blaming. No name calling. No interrupting. State the problem as the other person sees it. Express personal responsibility. Brainstorm solutions to satisfy both. Affirm, forgive or thank the other person.

If we do not accept that peace begins and ends with each individual, we will never have a peaceful world.

Spirit of Peace, help me to follow you even when it is hard to love and easy to hate.
